The Speciality Coffee Community activity seeks to increase coffee farmers income and profitability through an inclusive approach with buyers, reducing/eliminating inefficiencies and improve quality in their production and processing chains, while increasing access to international certified and specialty coffee markets

## **HOW DOES SMALL FARMER SOLUTIONS WORK?**

This activity reduces and or eliminates field-Inefficiencies in the coffee production value chains, lack of consistent quality, and lack of market access lead to low prices, losses, indebtedness, and increased pressure to grow coca.

## **EXPECTED RESULTS**

- By the end of the project, 3,200 producers register a profitability of 33% in the production of certified and specialty coffee
- During the same period, profits from coffee sales will increase from the current 33% loss to 33% profit.
- 12,500 Has of coffee under agroforestry systems
- Coffee production has increased from 129,400 to 279,800 QQ
